

**Knitting Wired-** November 5-7, 2010

This class will focus on the innovative exploration of the materials and fiber structure. Students will learn different ways to form knit stitches with wire using traditional knitting needles as well as forming more regular stitches with a crochet hook. Students will create and explore designing their own jewelry objects including attaching findings to the work. The class will also cover Viking knitting, tubular structures as well as plying in beads and other objects.

Supply list:

Size 2-5 metal knitting needles (7" double pointed best)

Crochet hooks of various smaller sizes

Jewelry pliers

20, 26-28 gauge wire or beads or other found objects with holes in them, if you have them

Wire spools (\$7 each) and other materials will also be available for purchase from the instructor as needed

This can be fine work so bring magnifiers, if you use them
