

## My 3 Favorite Techniques (Three day class)

Three techniques I use all the time to make work that is wildly original and different each quilt, are these: free piecing, triangular units and appliqueing bias tape. In this three-day class we will work on one of these each day and explore how you can use these techniques to make wholly original quilts of your own. Using the arc of the class to demonstrate my own approach to designing and making quilts, I will make sure you leave the class with a new way of thinking and a new tool set for your work.

### Supplies:

Approximately 6 yards (or more) of a variety of fabrics. Please bring at least  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard of striped fabric, a few  $\frac{1}{2}$  yards of solids and some larger pieces from different collections. Bring a 1 yard length of fabric to make into bias tape.

$\frac{1}{2}$ " and  $\frac{1}{4}$ " bias tape makers

Sewing machine and all standard supplies, rulers, rotary cutter, mat, etc.
